A seaside trip awaits over 100 of the world's best cyclists on Thursday 7 September when Felixstowe hosts the start and finish of stage 5 of the Tour of Britain cycle race. The stage marks Suffolk's first appearance in the Tour of Britain since 2017, although it will be the fifth time in modern race history that the peloton will have raced through the county. Felixstowe has never previously welcomed the Tour of Britain, however its sister race, the Women's Tour, dramatically culminated there in 2021. Flu Vaccine Clinics – Flu vaccine clinics are Wednesday 20 September – Aldeburgh Old Generator Station; Tuesday 26 September – Orford Surgery; Thursday 5 October – Hollesley Village Hall. Eligible groups: Everyone 65 years and over; those in clinical risk groups; pregnant women; all children aged 2 or 3 years and primary school aged children; residents in care and nursing homes; carers in receipt of carers allowance or the main carer of an elderly or disabled person; frontline workers in a social care setting; close contacts of immunocompromised individuals.

We have sent texts with links to online booking for flu vaccine appointments. Please ensure we have the up-to-date contact details for you as this is the quickest way to book your appointment. If you have registered a preference for another form of contact, we will have sent you a letter or email invite. If you believe you are eligible for a flu vaccine and have not heard from us, please call the surgery after 11.00am. We are organising flu clinics directly with care and nursing homes. If you are registered as housebound, we are contacting you directly to organise your vaccine. If you believe yourself to be medically housebound and are unsure if we have you registered as such, please call the surgery after 11.00am. At the time of publication, we are hoping to deliver the Covid vaccinations at the same time as our flu vaccine, however, this is dependent on national protocol and vaccine delivery.
