BAWDSEY PARISH COUNCIL

Did the 18 November Parish Council meeting make a difference? We believe so: We were pleased to have many residents taking part at the November meeting, and there was a useful sharing of experience and ideas about key aspects for the future of the village. There were some practical and interesting suggestions about how to make a significant increase in tree planting in Bawdsey, and also a clear commitment from all present to bring our speed limits in and around the village to recognise current (and anticipated) levels of traffic. We also forwarded comments to the Highways Department about the management of parking along Ferry Road towards the Quay; this should be available for public consultation in due course. We are in the process of obtaining a licence for putting some benches along the bank there as well. The next key decision will be to agree the precept for 2022 – at the meeting we made our intention clear of setting this based on the level of inflation, so any increase will be fairly small.

Latest PVCLT Information on School Meadow: The main contractor, Brooks and Wood, hopes to make a start on the site, week beginning 6 December, provided final local authority approval has been received.

Photographic History of Bawdsey: We are fortunate to have a wealth of photos of Bawdsey relating to the Quilter era as well as many from RAF Bawdsey days. There are far fewer from the post war era of 1950-2000 when village life was thriving with cricket and tennis clubs, Brownies and Cubs, a WI, a popular pub as well as village fetes, donkey derbies and jubilee celebrations. Not to mention the village school and church events. If you have any photos which reflect this time which can be reproduced clearly, please contact Jenny on 410198. Photos relating to farming would also be of interest especially of livestock and those working on the land.

HELP IMPROVE AIR QUALITY IN YOUR HOME

East Suffolk residents are being reminded of the importance of only burning seasoned firewood at home this winter, to help reduce air pollution and improve their health. Many homes in East Suffolk have open fires or wood-burning stoves. However, people may not be aware that these can contribute to air pollution and reduce indoor air quality, which can be damaging to health. To help reduce emissions, both indoors and into the environment, there are simple steps which homeowners can take:

- Consider burning less. If your house is already warm, then consider not lighting the fire, which will reduce both costs and airborne particulates.
- Only burn dry (seasoned) wood
- Buy 'Ready to Burn' fuel. For more information on the Ready to Burn Scheme, see www.readytoburn.org
- Do not burn treated waste wood (eg old furniture or pallets) or household rubbish
- Consider using an approved smokeless fuel a list of approved smokeless fuels is available at www.hetas.co.uk
- If you are buying a new stove check it is Defra approved and have it installed by a qualified person.
- Regularly maintain and service your stove -Get your chimney swept regularly
