**Bawdsey Parish Council is looking for a new Clerk**: Following the resignation of Tiffany Pollock, ex-clerk Jenny Webb has taken over until the end of March. **Precept 2022-23**: The parish council element of the Council Tax has remained unchanged for three years. This year the council has decided to raise the precept by just under 4 % to £7,950 adding just a few pounds to a Band D property. The council is faced with additional costs this year most specifically in the rationalisation of parking along Ferry Road with plans for new lay-bys, seating and planters. **Queen's Platinum Jubilee**: The council is receiving an oak tree from East Suffolk Council to mark this event. The planting of the tree will form part of the celebrations taking place on the recreation ground over the long weekend of 2-5 June. **A new Sub-Committee to implement a 20 mph along East Lane**: Following a petition of over 100 signatures asking for a new speed limit of 20mph along East Lane, the parish council decided to set up a Sub-Committee tasked with implementing this initiative. There are a number of different steps which need to be carried out in tandem with Suffolk Highways including a public consultation.
