#### EAST LANE 20 MPH SPEED ZONE

An update on the petition you may have signed to have East Lane designated as a 20 MPH Speed Zone. After submitting the petition to Bawdsey Parish Council (BPC), East Suffolk Council and the Highways Department, a Speed Survey was commissioned to show that if we met certain criteria, the scheme would be eligible for consideration. This was successful and we met the criteria. Work is now continuing, with a full quote for the installation being prepared in the autumn, when a new highways contractor is appointed. It is assumed that the cost will be met from various Council budgets with a contribution from BPC. It is proposed that the Speed Zone will include East and School Lanes, from the junctions with The Street down to the junction of the two lanes immediately beyond the school.

Thanks to all who signed and supported the petition. The work will go some way to improving the safety of all of us using the school and the two lanes.
