There will be no clinical staff available during this afternoon at any site. When the surgery is closed please call NHS 111.

Flu and Covid Vaccinations: Our flu vaccinations are starting on 4 October:

- Tuesday 4 October 2022 – Orford Surgery
- Wednesday 12 October 2022 – The Older Generator Station, Aldeburgh
- Thursday 20 October 2022 – Hollesley Village Hall

You can book your vaccine either online, or by phoning the surgery after 11.00am. Everyone aged 50 and over will be among those offered a Covid19 booster and a separate flu jab this winter, under plans to increase protection against respiratory illnesses. There are plans to offer the free flu vaccine to additional groups and we will keep you posted with details as we receive them.

We are expecting to be able to offer the Covid vaccine for those eligible at the same time as the flu clinics and have requested delivery in time for this. Details will be updated on the website and social media as soon as we know more details.

Currently eligibility for Covid vaccines includes:

- All adults aged 50 and over (starting with the over 75s),
- Those aged 5-49 in a clinical risk group, including pregnant women;
- Those aged 5-49 who are household contacts of people with immunosuppression,
- Those aged 16-49 who are carers,
- Residents in a care home for older adults and staff working in a care home for older adults
- Frontline health and social care workers.
