Public Space Protection Orders – Dog Controls in the Suffolk Coastal District

I am writing to advise you that the Council is considering amending the various dog controls currently in force across the Suffolk Coastal District.

Currently, there are several by-laws and an order made under the Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996 which are in force and impose requirements on dog owners including prohibiting dogs from certain areas, requiring owners to clean up after their dogs on most open land, and also requiring dogs to be kept on a lead in certain defined areas.

The Council is proposing to introduce "Public Space Protection Orders" to replace these controls as set out in the detailed consultation documents available for download on the Council's website at http://www.eastsuffolk.gov.uk/environment/environmental-protection/animals/dog-control/public-space-protection-orders/

There are some significant changes in some areas, and only minor changes proposed in others, and some of the controls remain the same, so please take the time to read these proposals.

All consultation responses will be given due consideration before any orders are made. The final decision will rest with Suffolk Coastal District Council and will be scheduled for consideration by Cabinet at a meeting after the consultation has closed.
