LETTER FROM BAWDSEY PARISH COUNCIL

Dear Parishioner

You may be aware that, following the recommendations of the Civil Contingencies Act, Bawdsey Parish Council has established a Community Emergency Plan. Since we are a rural community some distance from the Emergency Services bases it may be some time, should an emergency occur, before they can attend in the village. The aim of the Community Plan is to be ready to react constructively to any emergency until such time as the Emergency Services arrive and, if requested, to assist those Services when they do. The plan has been developed in co-operation with Alderton Parish Council.

Emergencies might include extended outages of electricity or water supplies, severe weather or generalised flooding causing roads to be cut off or damage to property, a nuclear leak from Sizewell, aircraft crash or major incident at sea locally. Such emergencies could lead to the need for evacuation.

When first developing this plan, a few years ago, we asked parishioners to fill in a questionnaire to help us prepare the plan. Some time has now passed, so to keep the plan up to date we would be grateful if you would answer the enclosed questionnaire. Part I gives information which will be useful to both the Emergency Services and the local Parish Team and includes information of those who might need specialised help and Part 2 is to identify those people who might be able to assist us if and when an emergency occurs.

Providing this information is, of course, voluntary. All this information will remain confidential to the Parish Council, Parish Clerk and the Coordinating Officer and will be used only in accordance with Government Data Protection guidelines once an emergency has been declared by The Parish Emergency officers or the Local Authority. The Parish Council is registered with the Information Commissioner's Office for Data Protection purposes. We are obliged to update this information annually.

We will be most grateful if you would complete the attached questionnaire.
