**East Anglia ONE Onshore Cable Route**  
**Construction activity in your area**

Dear Sir/Madam


I am writing to you about construction activity in your area in relation to the East Anglia ONE offshore windfarm project.

As you may know, the onshore cable route is about 37 km (23 miles) long. The majority of the route will be constructed using open trench methods, other than at locations where the route must go under a major transport network or natural obstacle. In these locations our contractors will use Horizontal Direct Drilling (HDD) techniques. HDD is a trenchless method, used to install ducts beneath the ground, through which the power cables for East Anglia ONE will later be pulled.

A HDD site is planned to commence in a location close to you. This is detailed below.

**Landfall – Bawdsey**

Contractors are currently setting up their compound on the site accessed on Ferry Road. Drilling is expected to commence w/c 19 March and take up to approximately three months.



Work is anticipated to take place between 07.00 and 19.00 seven days a week, however, the site has been granted approval for 24 hour working, if this is required. It is also likely that there will be no work carried out on the site over the Easter Bank Holiday weekend Friday 30 March to Monday 2 April. The most noticeable part of the works is expected to be the power generators and the presence of a large drill rig, rather than any noise or vibration from the drilling.
