

Report from Rob Johnson for BPC Meeting of 22nd January 2020

Speedwatch - The unit was repaired and is now back in position. We have added another lock on the bottom of the unit for extra security. We were due to operate a camera speedwatch the last two weeks but because of the road works that was not possible.

Village Hall & Rec Committee - The committee formally thanked the parish council for the donation of £500 towards the works carried out on the pavilion. We noted the information from both James Mallinder and Richard Tricker re village hall grants for energy saving and building refurbishments. It has been agreed to purchase a new cabinet to be housed in the back room for items relating to the pop-up pub. Committee asked when the last items can be moved from the old parish council filing cabinet as Emergency planning items are to be moved and locked in this cabinet.

Emergency Planning - Alderton now has a new representative from the parish council on the emergency planning committee, Will Palmer. We are looking to have a meeting of the committee late February. I am currently updating the Emergency Plan which I will send a copy to the parish council to be put on file. I am also trying to arrange rest centre training for a number of committee members.
